Editorial

I.G.F.'s President

Starting with October 2011 I.G.F. sets off on a new road. According to the General Assembly's decision, the new Administration Board will try to prove the usefulness of the change made in 2011. While continuing the good things achieved so far, we will aim at applying new measures that could remove the deficiencies. Our entire activity will be based on I.G.F.'s Charter and By-laws. As promised at the General Assembly, the dictatorship of one person will disappear; instead, the democratic principle of conversation, dialogue, understanding and friendship will be implemented. Friendship should not however be wrongly understood. Being friends does not mean being exempted from contributions or enjoying Charter-violating favours. We will be friends with everybody that complies with I.G.F. and that furthers the nice noble ideas of humanism. We will fight kitsch and any international events only arranged for enjoying material and financial gains. Beginning with 2011 I.G.F. rejects any and all events that are political in character or that aim at a financial gain. Our duty is to further and to support the real universal values. I am very confident in the new Administration Board ; therefore we introduced, for the first time in I.G.F.'s history,

the Board member certificates and badges. We will very soon send such certificates to all I.G.F. member Federations. We do not wish quantity for the sake of number. On the contrary, we want quality ; therefore we will keep on maintaining within the I.G.F. only the Federations that observe the Charter and that are really active. The new departments that we have created have the obligation to incessantly monitor I.G.F.'s Federations' activities, which will be published and furthered in the pages of our magazine.

At the Sofia meeting we inaugurated and had I.G.F.'s new flag blessed. We wish a real attachment to this symbol, which reminds our predecessors' efforts and beginnings. The flag will be present at all I.G.F. meetings and we have the obligation of keeping it with honesty and dignity. For furthering the I.G.F. we also opened the new website www.igfunion.eu, which is operable and will make our entire activity popular.

We hope that the new I.G.F. Festival, which will be called WORLD FOLK STARS, will enjoy the support of all Federations and will offer praiseworthy rewards to our folk groups. The first edition, which will be held in Bulgaria in 2012, will bring on the stage representative groups from

six countries. This is a beginning, at which we would love to have the presence of all Federations' chairmen. The Oscar Prizes for Folklore will continue to be granted, however this celebration will take place in a civilised framework, arranged according to the regulations approved of within the Administration Board.

I once more express my confidence in the new Administration Board and also in the support and collaboration of all I.G.F. colleagues. The current magazine, which supersedes last years' newsletters, is open to all I.G.F. members. I am eagerly looking forward to receiving deliverables and propositions for a representation that be as interesting and useful and possible.

Seeing that we are still at the beginning of a new year, I wish all I.G.F. members a year full of accomplishments and successes in furthering and capitalising world folklore.



I.G.F.'s General October 14th – 16th, 2011

Bistrița, Romania was the meeting place of all I.G.F. members. Between October 14th and 16th, 2011 all I.G.F. members were invited to take part in this important event. Apart from the talks linked to last years' activity, the ultimate issue was the election of the new chairman and of the new Administration Board. I.G.F.'s works were held



in the elegant premises of 'George Coșbuc' Municipal Cultural Centre of Bistrița. In the presence of a numerous audience (more than 400 people) composed of folklore specialists and members of Romania's National Folklore Federation, the works

conducted by I.G.F.'s Board and by official guests representing national and local authorities, began. The Romanian Federation was thanked for the organisation of this ample meeting and for the constant work carried out within I.G.F. The meeting was

attended by delegations from Italy, Israel, Portugal, Turkey, Slovakia, The Salomon Islands, Hungary, Croatia, France, Spain, Latvia, Ukraine, Switzerland, Greece, Ireland, Cyprus, Lithuania, Mexico, The Czech Republic, Bulgaria and Romania. 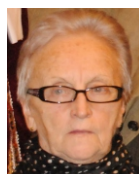

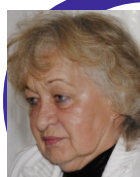

I.G.F.'s Administration Board was held in Sofia, Bulgaria between December 27th and 29th, 2011. It was the first meeting of the new Administration Board after the elections within October 2011 General Assembly.

Interpreters delegated from National Folklore Federations of Bulgaria-Romania (Mihai Berbunshi, Doris Cosma), France (Zelida Charléty), Nino Indaimo (Italy) were also present as guests.

The Administration Board validated the inclusion in the Board of two more members, namely Vladan Tesanovici (Serbia) and Birute Akelaitiene (Lithuania).

For the first time in I.G.F.'s history, all the members of the Administration Board received Board member Certificates and special Badges.

1 One set up five work departments, which are listed in Appendix 1 and you are kindly invited to express your wish of working in one or two of these departments. Please notify your choice in writing to I.G.F.'s chairman, who afterwards will let know your intention to the department chairmen. The departments' analysis will be made on each I.G.F. Board.

Appendix 2 specifies I.G.F. Board's works.

2 One set up the General Rules for awarding the World Oscar Prizes for Folklore, as well as the holding place between 2012 and 2014. All these can be found in Appendix

3 One set up the organisation of I.G.F.'s own Festival that replaces the former Grand Prix' kitsch and unclear businesses. The festival organised by I.G.F. will bear the World Folk Stars name and will be arranged according to the Regulations stipulated in Appendix 4.

4 I.G.F.'s new flag was presented and blessed. It is made of silk and it has I.G.F.'s logo embroidered thereon. We thus replaced the plastic kitsch used till the previous year. The flag was handed to the Bul-

garian Federation, which will keep it in a visible place until the first I.G.F.'s meeting. I.G.F.'s Secretary general is directly responsible for the flag handing over based on a signature.

5 One proceeded to updating I.G.F.'s members, the fictitious names who have never taken part in any I.G.F. activity were removed, as they had only been there from the former leader's imagination. The complete list can be found in Appendix 5, on the specification that on the future new meeting, the activity-free Federations or the ones that do not comply with I.G.F.'s charter or decisions will be excluded and some other Federations will be registered.

6 Seeing the amplitude of the future events and

the support that I.G.F. intends to provide to all events, one decided to increase the contributions amount, as follows:

- from EUR 100 to EUR 150
- from EUR 200 to EUR 300
- from EUR 300 to EUR 500

We will thus be able to support such important events as World Folk Star and many others.

We kindly ask all I.G.F. colleagues to check up the contributions breakdown, to pay their arrears (where applicable), so that we could set off in 2012 with new energies and with outstanding achievements. The new contributions enter into force from January 1st, 2012.

7 Our new website, www.igfunion.eu, was opened for an optimal collaboration and furtherance of I.G.F.

8 Given the activity carried out throughout the years, the Administration Board decided to award honorific titles that did not exist in the Charter so far. These approved titles are part of the Internal By-laws and can be granted or withdrawn by the Administration Board and by the General Assembly on account of the majority vote. The two approved titles are : I.G.F.'s Honour president and I.G.F.'s Senator.

The honorific titles are awarded for special merits by the General Assembly or by the Administration Board and the owners of these titles will have the following obligations and duties :

- to observe I.G.F.;
- to further I.G.F.'s ideas and activities;
- to support I.G.F. by their power;
- they may participate, as guests, at I.G.F.'s General Assemblies, they can make propositions regarding I.G.F.'s activity,

but they may neither elect (vote) nor be elected in the managing structure;

- they neither may nor have the right to speak or to sign documents or letters on behalf of I.G.F..

The Administration Board from Sofia entirely carried out its works according to I.G.F.'s Charter, so that the decisions made as a result of the unanimous agreement become



mandatory for all I.G.F. members. We take this opportunity to thank once more the Bulgarian National Folklore Federation and especially our colleague, Rosen Bogdanov, for their kindness and for the good organisation of this meeting.

I wish all I.G.F. members a year as good as it may be, good luck in every aspect and I am looking forward to dearly seeing you at the 2012 folklore events.

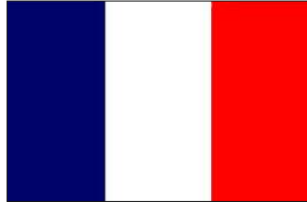

The 'Oscar' Folklore Awards

1. It will only be awarded to the cultural personalities who are active in the field of folk culture. Any nomination of political entities (such as parties, governors etc.) is forbidden.
2. The maximum age for being awarded an Oscar prize is 75 years old. Exception will be discussed in the board council.
3. Only one template will be adopted for the 'Oscar' trophy, with the year and the receiving person's name marked on it.
4. 5 - 7 Oscar prizes at the most, which will have been analyzed and decided within the I.G.F.'s Board as a result of the Federations' propositions, will be awarded each year. Each federation who has nominate a person for the Oscar prize will be entire responsible for the presence of that person at the ceremony and in case of absent that person will be excluded of discussion for 5 years.
5. All the CVs will be kept, duly registered, at the General Secretariat, subsequently followed by the awarding minutes bearing the reception signatures.
6. The absence of a nominee will entail the postponing of the awarding on a later date. Exception: the post-mortem cases.
7. The propositions may only be made by the federations' chairmen or by I.G.F.'s chairman for outstanding people within I.G.F.'s Board or for great world cultural figures.
8. The few important criteria below will be taken into account for the Oscar propositions:

For music personalities:
Conductors, composers, instrumentalists, solists/singers etc.
- At least 5 personal CDs or
- Two books, musical

collections or

- The title of International Honored Artist

For choreographers:

- At least 10 suites of dances put on and certified by documents (press, diplomas etc.)
- Two presences in The World's Folklore Gala, with their own shows put on — or
- The title of International Honored Choreographer Artist

For researchers, collectors, band conductors or other cultural personalities:

- At least 10 specialized columns in the national press and 2 in the international press, including I.G.F.'s Journal, or
- At least three cultural specialty books published.

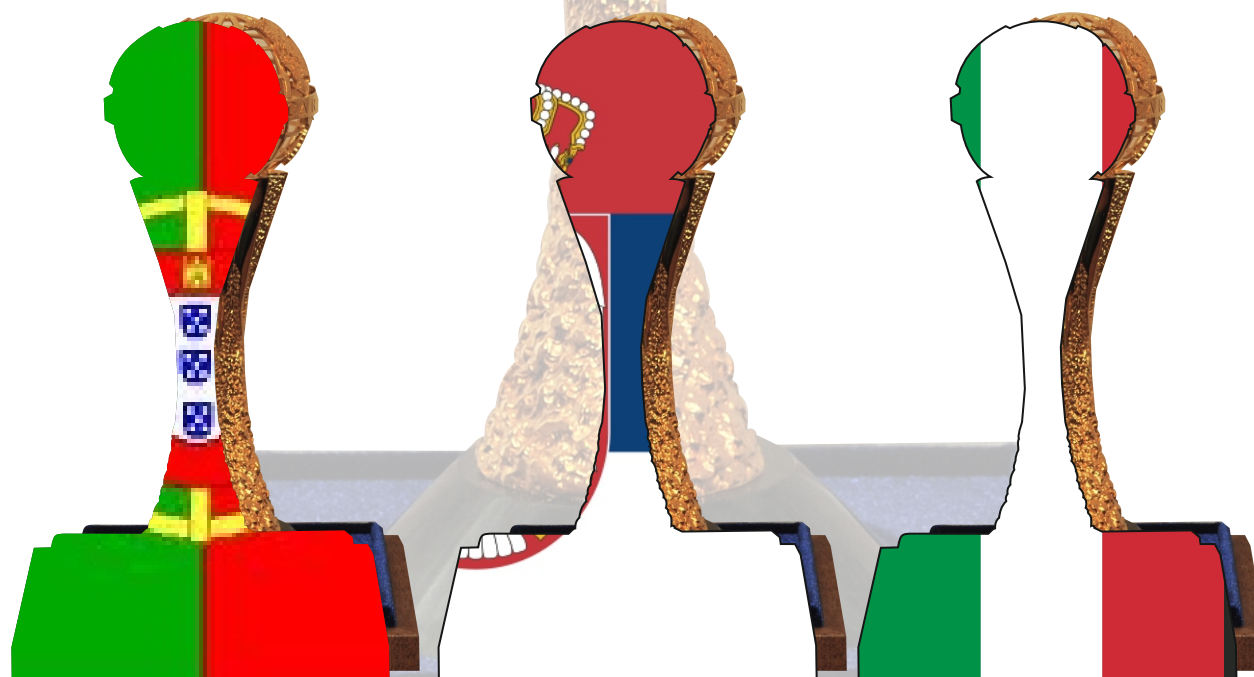
9. All the propositions will be submitted to I.G.F.'s chairman and to the general secretariat till March 15th of each year. The Secretary General and the Deputy Secretary General will analyze the files received and whether all the criteria will have been met. The conclusions will be sent

to I.G.F.'s Board and scientific council, which will decide on the prize awarding.

10. The ceremony of the Oscar folklore prize will take place in theater hall with a large number of audiences. The organizer federation has the duty to assure publicity in entire mass-media and the press conference first of and after the ceremony. When the prize will be offered it will be played the national hymn of the award it person's country.

Each federation has the obligation to respect this regulation.

World's Folklore Stars

1. An event that should replace the kitsch and the dirty businesses from the Grand Prix.
2. Attendance of at least six countries, which will have been decided within the I.G.F.'s Board upon the proposal of each Federation chairman and in this way each country will participate approximately every three or four years.
3. There will be no contest. The attending groups will receive the title of 'International Honored Folk Group', which will account for that group's international value acknowledgment. Each Federation will obviously delegate great artistic value groups.
4. The choreographers and the conductors will be awarded titles of international honored artists.
5. Each organizer federation will provide accommodation and meals for those 6 groups, but the transport will belong to the invited group or to the representing federation.
6. I.G.F. will support financial the organizing country.
7. First edition (2012) will be organized in Bulgaria and I.G.F. members should express in write their wish to participate, but the organizers can decide about those 6 participating groups.

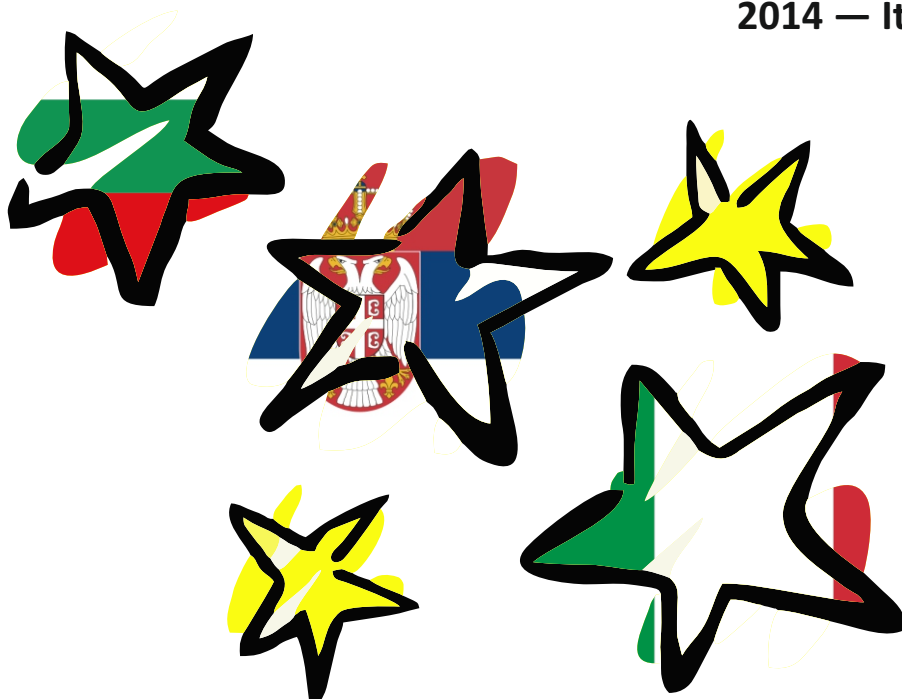
